



The World of Islam

- Islam is the world's second largest religious group.
- Islam has 1.6 billion followers, making 23 % of the world population.
- Most Muslims are either of two denominations:
 - □ Sunni (80–85%)
 - □ Shia (15-20%.)
- ▶ There are 50 Muslim majority countries in the world.
- Islam is the dominant religion in Central Asia, Indonesia, Middle East, North Africa, and sub-Saharan Africa.
- The history of the Muslim world spans about 1400 years.

Where did Islam Begin?

- Islam began in the 7th century C.E. in Mecca, among the Arabian people on the Peninsula of Arabia.
- It was founded by the prophet Mohammad.
- According to Mohammad, he received the Quran from God through the Mediator, Archangel Gabriel.

Who are the Arabians?

- Arabians are an ethnic group belong to the Peninsula of Arabia.
- Nomads / Bedouins (man of the desert)
- Descendent from Abraham (Ibrahim) through Ishmael his firstborn son from the maidservant Hagar.
- Nowadays; Saudi Arabia, Yemen, Oman, and Gulf countries(Emirates – Qatar – Bahrain – Kuwait)

The Arabs

"The Arabs are the people who converted to Islam and adopted the Arabic language and Islamic culture."



Who is Mohammad?

- According to the Muslims sources, Mohammad was born in 570 C.E. in the town of Mecca
- Muslims believe that, when he was 40, the Angel Gabriel appeared to him in a cave where he was meditating.
- Mohammad claimed that Gabriel gave him the messages from God (Allah) to tell his people for 23 year until his death at age 62, on 632 A.D.
- These messages were compiled into the Qur'an.
- Mohammad did not write the Qur'an.



Translation: Mohammad, God's prayer and peace be upon him

Who is Mohammad?

- Muslims do not regard Mohammad as divine/equal to God (Allah), but he is just a prophet.
- Muslims believe that the prophets of the Hebrew Scriptures and Jesus were true prophets.
- There are no pictures of Mohammad.
- It is prohibited to have pictures of the prophets.
- It is considered idolatry.




Translation: Muhammad, God's prayer and peace be upon him

What is the Qur'an?

- ► The Holy Book of Muslims.
- ► The word Quran means **recitation**.
- Mohammad claimed that these text was given to him from Allah through Gabriel.
- It consists of 114 Sura (books)
- The Quran is organized by the size of the Sura (book) (from largest to smallest) not chronologically.




Quran verses, Classic Arabic



What is the Qur'an?

- Muhammad did not write the Qur'an.
- It was written 20 40 years after his death, by the 3rd Caliph (successor) Uthman.
- The Qur'an addresses humanity regarding worship, beliefs, wisdom, laws and other guidelines for faithful living.



What is The Hadiths?

- ▶ Hadiths are the record of the Mohammed's teachings, words, & deeds.
- ▶ It is the second most important textbook in Islam next to the Quran.
- Although not regarded as the spoken word of God like the Quran,
- ▶ The Hadith is an important source of doctrine, law, and practice.

How does Islam relate to other religions?

- Islam is one of the Abrahamic family of faiths that also includes Judaism and Christianity.
- Muslims recognize Abraham, Moses, Jesus and other Biblical figures as part of their religion.
- Muslims believe that Mohammad is descendent of Ishmael son of Abraham.
- They believe in the same creation story of Adam & Eve.
- Islam doesn't believe in the fall and the original sin.
- Adam & Eve came t earth to teach humanity what they learned in heaven.
- They believe in the Angels as well as Satan (Shitan) who rebelled against God and was punished.







How does Islam relate to C

□ Jesus in Islam

- Islam believe that Jesus was born without a father, "Virgin Birth ".
- Islam denies that Jesus is Son of God and consider that as a blasphemy.
- Jesus is not divine; he is only human and just a Prophet.
- Quran admits that he performed many miracles, such as raised dead, healed the sick, and casted out bad spirits.
- Islam believe that Jesus was not crucified.
- Jesus was not deceased but was left to heaven alive.
- Muslim believe that Jesus will be back to kill the Anti-Christ and reign for 40 years.
